

- 1) Begin your time by briefly praying and asking the Holy Spirit to help you as you discuss and study.
- 2) As a group, describe a church? What is a church supposed to be? What is a church supposed to do? What are things a church is not supposed to do?
- 3) Read Acts 2:42-47 together.
- 4) What stuck out to you as you read? Is there anything you didn't understand? Is there anything you'd like to discuss?
- 5) Describe the church based on Acts 2:42-47. What could a church be based on this passage?
- 6) Based on this passage, what do you think is probably most lacking in our church? Where do we need to grow? Where do we need God's help?
- 7) Read Mark 12:28-34 together.
- 8) What stuck out to you as you read? Is there anything you didn't understand? Is there anything you'd like to discuss?
- 9) Who is the person in your life who best exemplifies verses 30-31? What are they like?
- 10) Jesus gives the greatest commandment, and then adds a second one, why do you think he gave two commandments?
- 11) End your time in prayer. Ask the Holy Spirit to help apply to your life what you've been learning and discussing.
