- 1) Begin your time by briefly praying and asking the Holy Spirit to help you as you discuss and study.
- 2) Read Mark 10:35-45 together.
- 3) What stuck out to you as you read? Is there anything you don't understand? Is there anything you'd like to discuss?
- 4) Do you think the request of James and John was wrong? Why or why not?
- 5) What does Jesus mean by "drink the cup that I drink" and "baptized with the baptism with which I am baptized?" What is he referring to?
- 6) When Jesus talks about how the Gentiles do things, he's referring to how the world (non-Christ-followers) do things. And then he talks about believers ought to do things. What is the difference in how we ought to operate according to Jesus?
- 7) Describe the best boss you've ever had, what made them a good leader?
- 8) What is it that Jesus does that makes him a perfect leader?
- 9) Read Matthew 25:31-40 together.
- 10) What stuck out to you as you read? Is there anything you don't understand? Is there anything you'd like to discuss?
- 11) Why is this teaching from Jesus so hard?
- 12) No one can do everything, but all of us are called to live sacrificial lives. How do we know when God is calling us to serve in a specific situation?
- 13) End your time in prayer. This week specifically pray for people whom you know who are not yet Christ followers. Ask God to open a door for them to hear the gospel and respond in faith.
