- 1) Begin your time by briefly praying and asking the Holy Spirit to help you as you discuss and study.
- 2) Read Mark 12:28-32, Ephesians 4:1-3, Matthew 28:18-20 together.
- 3) These three passages sum up the themes of gospel, family, and mission. If you were to self assess, which one of these verses are you obeying the best, and which one of these verses are you obeying the least?
- 4) Read Matthew 25:31-46 together.
- 5) What stuck out to you as you read? Is there anything you don't understand? Is there anything you'd like to discuss?
- 6) What is the criteria that Jesus gives in this passage for who ends up in Kingdom and who ends up in the eternal fire?
- 7) Who are the least of these that you regularly come in contact with? How is God calling you love them?
- 8) The Bible clearly teaches that heaven and hell are true realities that await those in Christ (heaven) and not in Christ (hell). Is it easy or hard for you to believe in heaven and hell? Explain.
- 9) This passage, read on its own, could seem to be teaching salvation by works, but we know that salvation is by grace. So how does this passage teach salvation by grace?
- 10) End your time in prayer. This week specifically pray for people whom you know who are not yet Christ followers. Ask God to open a door for them to hear the gospel and respond in faith.
