- 1) Begin your time by briefly praying and asking the Holy Spirit to help you as you discuss and study.
- 2) Read Luke 19:28-44 together.
- 3) What stuck out to you as you read? Is there anything you'd like to discuss?
- 4) By riding on a colt (a young donkey), Jesus is fulfilling a prophecy about the Messiah in Zechariah 9:9. Read that passage together. What sticks out to you?
- 5) Why did the people lay their coats on the ground and wave palm branches? What was the significance of this?
- 6) The people shouted "Hosanna, Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord." What does this mean?
- 7) These same people who rejoiced over Jesus' entry into Jerusalem would scream "crucify him" in just a few days. What does this sort of hypocrisy teach us about true worship?
- 8) Why do you think Jesus wept over Jerusalem?
- 9) What is Jesus prophesying in verses 42-44?
- 10) What did you notice in this passage about the heart and character of God?
- 11) As you think about this entire passage, what are your takeaways? Is there something you learned about God or yourself? Is there something you need to do? Is there something you need to repent of? Discuss.
- 12) End your time in prayer. Ask the Holy Spirit to help apply to your life what you've been learning and discussing.
