- 1) Begin your time by briefly praying and asking the Holy Spirit to help you as you discuss and study.
- 2) Read Proverbs 1:8-9 together.
- 3) These verses use somewhat poetic language, but what are they actually saying? Is the message in these verses always true?
- 4) What would you say good parenting looks like biblically? What does it involve?
- 5) Read Proverbs 14:26 together.
- 6) How should our families act as a refuge? How is this related to God?
- 7) Read Proverbs 20:7 together.
- 8) How would you define integrity? Why is it so important?
- 9) Read Proverbs 22:6 together.
- 10) Is this verse always true? Don't children have free will? What is the writer of Proverbs teaching?
- 11) Proverbs 24:3-4 together.
- 12) What are the riches (physical, spiritual, emotional, etc.) that you are seeking in your life and for your family? In other words, how do you envision the way you want things to be? What future are you aiming for? What do you want for your kids?
- 13) Read Proverbs 13:24 and Proverbs 23:13-14 together.
- 14) How did you learn to be disciplined? If you have kids, how are you seeking to teach your kids discipline?
- 15) End your time in prayer. Ask God to help you apply the things you've discussed and learned during this time of study.
