1) Begin your time by briefly praying and asking the Holy Spirit to help you as you discuss and study.

The sermon covered portions of Acts 3-5. These discussion questions cover only Acts 3 in order to fit into the time constraints of a typical community group.

- 2) Read Acts 3:1-26 together.
- 3) What stuck out to you as you read? Is there anything you don't understand? Is there anything you'd like to discuss?
- 4) What is the most challenging aspect of this text for you?
- 5) What aspect of this text do you think your church needs to hear the most?
- 6) Why should Christians care for people in need?
- 7) What are you doing to care for the broken?
- 8) What about this miracle most resonates with you? Why?
- 9) Does God heal people today? Explain.
- 10) Is there anyone in your life whom you are trying to lead to salvation in Christ? If so, how does this text inspire and instruct you?
- 11) How should the authority of Jesus impact the way you live this week?
- 12) End your time in prayer. Ask God to help you apply the things you've discussed and learned during this time of study.
