- 1) Begin your time by briefly praying and asking the Holy Spirit to help you as you discuss and study.
- 2) Read Romans 8:9-11 together.
- 3) What stuck out to you as you read? Is there anything you don't understand? Is there anything you'd like to discuss?
- 4) What marks a true Christian according to Romans 8:9?
- 5) How can a Christian know he/she has the Holy Spirit?
- 6) Notice all the different names or phrases that refer to the Holy Spirit in these verses. List them as a group. What do all of these different names for the Holy Spirit teach us?
- 7) According to these verses, why is the resurrection of Jesus important?
- 8) What do you find assuring and astonishing in Romans 8:9–11?
- 9) What do you look forward to most about your future resurrection?
- 10) End your time in prayer. Ask God to help you apply the things you've discussed and learned during this time of study.
