

- 1) Begin your time by briefly praying and asking the Holy Spirit to help you as you discuss and study.
- 2) Read Romans 8:14-17 together.
- 3) What stuck out to you as you read? Is there anything you don't understand? Is there anything you'd like to discuss?
- 4) What does it mean to be led by the Spirit of God (v.14) in the context of Romans 8?
- 5) In verse 15, Paul connects "the spirit of slavery" with "fear," what is he talking about?
- 6) Why is the term "Abba" (v.15) significant?
- 7) How has God revealed himself to you in a personal and intimate way?
- 8) Verse 16 talks about how the Holy Spirit bears witness with our spirit that we are truly children of God. Has this happened to you? Describe this. Discuss this.
- 9) What does it mean to be an heir of God (v.17)? What do we inherit?
- 10) In verse 17, Paul connects our suffering with our salvation. He says that we must suffer with Jesus in order to also be glorified with Jesus. Is this teaching "salvation by works?" Why or why not?
- 11) End your time in prayer. Ask God to help you apply the things you've discussed and learned during this time of study.
