DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1) Begin your time by briefly praying and asking the Holy Spirit to help you as you discuss and study.
- 2) Read Ephesians 6:10-20 together.
- 3) What stuck out to you as you read? Was there anything that you didn't understand? Discuss.

This week's sermon is focused specifically on the belt of truth and the breastplate of righteousness. These questions revolve around those two pieces of armor.

- 4) What is the belt of truth? What does it mean to fasten on the belt of truth?
- 5) Have you ever / do you struggle to believe that the Bible is God's word, and that it is true? Discuss?
- 6) The Bible makes many statements about its own truthfulness. Read together: John 17:17, 2 Timothy 3:16, 2 Peter 1:20-21.
- 7) What stuck out to you as you read? Was there anything that you didn't understand? Discuss.
- 8) Truth is very much under attack in our culture, how do you see this happening?
- 9) What is the breastplate of righteousness? What does it mean to put on the breastplate of righteousness?
- 10) The essence of the Gospel is that we are given a righteousness outside of ourselves by faith in Christ. Read together: Romans 8:1-4, Titus 3:4-7.
- 11) What stuck out to you as you read? Was there anything that you didn't understand? Discuss.

- 12) Sometimes we forget that our righteousness comes through Christ, and we revert to trying to earn our righteousness. When do you feel this happening to you? What personally helps you to rest in the righteousness of Jesus?
- 13) End your time in prayer. Ask the Holy Spirit to help apply to your life what you've been learning and discussing.
