

SERMON DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

WEEK 12: Colossians 3:12-17

- 1) Begin your time by briefly praying and asking the Holy Spirit to help you as you discuss and study.
- 2) Now, read Colossians 3:12-17 together.
- 3) What stuck out to you as you read? Was there anything that you didn't understand? Discuss.
- 4) In verse 13, Paul commands us to bear with one another and forgive one another. Why do you think this is so hard to do?
- 5) In verse 15, Paul tells us to "let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts." This can be especially hard when life is hard, or when it seems out of control (can anyone say "coronavirus"). What helps you personally to feel at peace?
- 6) Verse 16 says, "Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly, teaching and admonishing one another in all wisdom, singing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, with thankfulness in your hearts to God." How do you see this verse playing out in your MC and at 24 church? Is there an area where we need to improve? If so, what? And, how?
- 7) Verse 17 says that everything we do should be done for the glory of God. Where do you see this playing out in your life? How do you need to improve?
- 8) End your time in prayer. Ask the Holy Spirit to help apply to your life what you've been learning and discussing.
