

## SERMON DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

WEEK 14: Colossians 4:2-6

- 1) Begin your time by briefly praying and asking the Holy Spirit to help you as you discuss and study.
- 2) Now, read Colossians 4:2-6 together.
- 3) What stuck out to you as you read? Was there anything that you didn't understand? Discuss.
- 4) Paul begins by telling the Colossians to "continue steadfastly in prayer" (verse 2). Obviously, we can't live on our knees with our eyes closed. Describe what you think a lifestyle of continuous steadfast prayer looks like? Have you ever known anyone you would describe as a "prayer warrior?" What was different about that person?
- 5) In verses 3-4, Paul is specifically asking for evangelistic prayer—he wants the gospel message to spread, and he wants to speak clearly and powerfully to those with whom he's sharing. What missionaries / pastors / ministers are you currently praying for as they share the gospel? Who are you personally praying for in regards to their salvation?
- 6) What does in mean to walk in wisdom towards outsiders (verse 5)?
- 7) Part of walking in wisdom towards outsiders involves speaking with gracious, seasoned speech. How can we do this well?
- 8) End your time in prayer. Ask the Holy Spirit to help apply to your life what you've been learning and discussing.
